1. Purpose of This Change

This change is part of your policy. It limits the amount we will pay under Section 7 of your policy, "Loss or Damage Coverages" for automobile electronic accessories and equipment, other than factory installed equipment, caused by theft or attempted theft to agreed amounts.

2. Definitions

"Electronic accessories and equipment" includes, but is not limited to, radios, tape players/decks, stereo players/decks, compact disc players, speakers, telephones, cellular telephones, two-way radios including CB radios, ham radios and VHF radios, televisions, facsimile machines, electronic navigation assistance, positioning and location finding devices, computers, and items of a similar nature.

"Factory installed equipment" means sound and electronic communication equipment which was included in the original new purchase price of the automobile.

3. What We Will Pay

If loss or damage to electronic accessories and equipment, other than factory installed equipment, is caused by theft or attempted theft, we will pay the actual cash value of the equipment up to \$1,500 in total, unless the equipment is listed below, in which case we will pay the limit shown for each item or the actual cash value of the equipment, whichever is the lesser. This coverage is subject to the deductible shown on your Certificate of Automobile Insurance.
